

Team Invitation

**Moscow - Shukolovo
February 25th, 2017**

Welcome to the **FIS Snowboard World Cup Parallel Slalom**, which will held on **Saturday 25th February, 2017** near Moscow in Shukolovo, at the "Leonid Tyagachev Ski Club", who have had the pleasure of hosting a FIS World Cup in PSL in 2007.

Russian Snowboard Federation will host the event in accordance with the FIS International Competition Rules (ICR). All athletes who are qualified according to the FIS Rules for the Snowboard World Cup are invited to take part in the competition.

1. PASSPORT and VISA

A foreign visitor traveling to Russia must have a passport **valid for at least next 6 months after the date of departure from Russia.**

In compliance with the personal data, a scanned formal invitation letter will be issued and e-mailed back to the participant.

PLEASE SEND OUT ALL PASSPORT INFORMATION BEFORE THE 10TH OF FEBRUARY!!!

The invitation letter is to be taken to the nearest Russian Consulate along with the corresponding personal documents such as a passport, the necessary number of photographs, completed application form, etc. We strongly recommend calling the Consulate if you have any questions and studying its website before taking the documents to the Consulate.

Please be advised that with the formal invitation letter for the **FIS Snowboard World Cup Parallel Slalom**, European citizens from the Schengen countries can submit their visa application to any Russian Consulate of any Schengen country, while citizens from USA, Canada, Australia and Great Britain, can submit their application to any Russian Consulate around the world regardless.

Please note: Russian embassy requires that any foreign visitor traveling to Russia has valid travel insurance.

2. Entries and important forms

3. Participation Fee

According to the World Cup Rules a mandatory Participation Fee of **CHF 30** per each competitor and competition day has to be paid to the organizing committee.

The Participation Fee has to be paid per nation and during the registration at the race office starting on Thursday 23rd of February, 2017.

4. Radio Frequencies and Communication

Due to a change in the Russian law regarding the radio-communication during big events such as the World Cup, all radio frequencies (RF) used by the participating teams have to undergo an electromagnetic compatibility (EMC) test. Based on those results, some frequencies would be classified as free others would be available under a certain price. In the second scenario the organising committee will cover the cost for the nation to use that RF or a different frequency would be assigned to them. In order to avoid complications with radio communications on the days of the event, please be ready to provide your radios for examination during your stay.

5. Registration

Team registration will take place daily starting Thursday 23rd February, 2017 at the race office. The race office will be located at the hotel.

6. Accommodation

As per the FIS Rule on accommodation and half-board, each participant will pay **CHF 80** day/person directly to the Organizing Committee FIS World Cup Moscow.

The sum is payable upon registration at the race office.

Accommodation at FIS rate will be provided from arriving on **February 23rd, 2017**, until departure on **February 26th, 2017**.*

Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay.

7. Transportation Airport/Hotel

The Organizing Committee will organize transport from the airport (Sheremetyevo and Domodedovo Airports) to the hotel and back. There will be people to meet you with World Cup signs.

8. Meals

Breakfast and dinner will be provided, starting on **Thursday 23rd February, 2017**, and finishing with on **Sunday 26th February, 2017**.

Breakfast and dinner will be organized at the hotel. During the event the Organizing Committee will provide competitors and coaches with drinking water, tea and snacks at the venue.

9. Bibs

All competitors must wear bibs during all official trainings, competitions and award ceremonies.

10. Accident insurance

Each competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, Russian Snowboard Federation, sponsors, suppliers, their agents and the FIS decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event.

11. Liability

All athletes, officials and members of the National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, «New League» Sports Club, Russian Snowboard Federation, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athletes, officials or other person in conjunction with the organizing or staging of the event.

12. Official notice board

The official notice board will be located at the race office as well as at the event welcome desk at the hotel.

13. Training

Trainings are to take place according to the schedule of the event.

14. Prize fund

The prize-winner receives the net prize money.

15. Announcements

An English-speaking announcer will be provided by the OC for the event.

16. Medical and Anti-Doping

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each event and gender.
