The Organizing Committee will host the event in accordance with the International Ski Competition Rules (ICR) of the International Ski Federation (FIS) and the rules for the Organization of the FIS World Championships. All National Ski Associations affiliated with the FIS are invited to compete.

2. ENTRIES:

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules. Please complete the enclosed Team Entry Form and remit to the Organizing Committee by email or fax:

National Ski Associations must submit their team numbers and names according to the FIS WSC rules:

- FIS Preliminary Team Entry Form, Due: October 30, 2010 (Team Size)
- FIS Entry Form, Due: January 12, 2011 (Freestyle FIS Code*, Participant Names and Gender)

*Competitors without Freestyle FIS points are allowed to participate

a. NATIONAL SKI ASSOCIATION TEAM QUOTAS:

- The maximum number of participants from each country shall be:
 - Maximum 32 participants with a maximum 18 of either gender plus the competitors according to WSC art. 9.3 (past or reigning 2009 FIS Freestyle World Champions). (WSC art. 9.1.4)
- Number of participants in each single event
 - o In each single event no more than (4) four competitors per National Ski Association plus the competitors according to WSC art. 9.3, are entitled to start (WSC art. 9.2)
- The maximum number of team officials, medical and technical personnel per national team shall be:
 - o Up to 3 competitors: 3 trainers, 2 doctors*, 2 technicians
 - o 4 or 5 competitors: 4 trainers, 2 doctors*, 3 technicians
 - o 6 to 14 competitors: 5 trainers, 2 doctors*, 4 technicians

*Medical personnel includes doctors, physiotherapists and first aid people. The figure of up to 14 competitors per gender applies to all nations. These quotas include the national team officials (team captains, etc.). (WSC art 9.4)

3. **REGISTRATION**:

Check-in, team registration, race headquarters and the team captains' meetings will take place at The Lodges at Deer Valley located in Snow Park Village, the base area of Deer Valley, (2900 Deer Valley Drive East). Team registration/lodging check-in will take place daily starting on **Sunday**, **January 30**, from 1 p.m. – 8 p.m.

All fees and deposits must be paid upon registration.

a. ENTRY CONFIRMED WITH PASSPORT:

 To be eligible to participate in the 2011 FIS Freestyle World Ski Championships, the competitor must be a citizen of the country of which National Ski Association he/she has a license and prove this with a valid passport. (WSC art. 8)

b. VISA REQUIREMENTS INFORMATION:

- Most Canadian citizens and many citizens from Visa Waiver Program countries can come to the United States (U.S.) without a visa if they meet certain requirements. All Visa Waiver Program travelers must present a machine-readable passport at the U.S. port of entry to enter the U.S. without a visa; otherwise a U.S. visa is required. Other foreign citizens will need a nonimmigrant visa, type B-1 in most cases

4. ACCOMMODATIONS:

Please submit your lodging needs to the Organizing Committee by the preliminary deadline of **October 30**, **2010**. All lodging needs must be finalized and submitted by **January 12**, **2011**. Lodging cancellations will be non-refundable and additional lodging

requests will not be accommodated for through the Organizing Committee after January 12, 2011.

Note: In agreement with FIS and according to WSC art. 17.5.2, given the local rooming configurations, conditions and locations to the courses, two arrangements for the events have been made for accommodations. Also, the Freestyle Committee selected the exchange rate as of June 1, 2010, of US \$86.50 to 100 CHF to calculate athlete per diem amounts.

Accommodations for Mogul and Aerial athletes and officials are provided at various condominiums in the Snow Park Village, the base area of Deer Valley Resort. Each condominium will have a fully equipped kitchen. The venue will collect US \$50 for each Mogul and Aerial athlete, per night.

Accommodations for Ski Cross and Ski Halfpipe athletes and officials are provided at Park City area hotels within close proximity to both venues. The venue will collect US \$35 for each Ski Cross and Ski Halfpipe athlete, per night.

Payment must be made at time of check-in via cash or credit card only.

All teams will depart on the morning of Sunday, February 6, 2011.

At the time of check-in, **a major credit card will be required** to cover all incidentals. Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during their stay. All lodging accommodations are non-smoking, NO EXCEPTIONS.

a. CONFIRMATION OF ACCOMODATION (WSC art. 17.5.5):

 ...the Organizing Committee must be informed at the latest 24 hours after the last FIS World Cup event before the championships about the name of the team members, eventual changes to the originally registered size of team (athletes according to WSC art 9.1 and officials according to WSC art. 9.4) and their arrival or departure dates, as well as an eventual withdrawal from the event. This deadline is the same as for the submission of the Final Team Selection, as described in WSC art. 13.3.3 of the FIS Rules for the Organization of World Championships

- If this information is not communicated by the published deadline of 24 hours after the last FIS World Cup event before the championships, the Organizing Committee has the right to invoice the costs incurred for cancelled accommodation to the National Ski Association concerned
- Teams or persons who register late and do not observe the published deadlines have no right for the reservation or the payment of accommodation expenses

To help us better prepare for your visit, please provide us with your flight arrival and departure information as soon as possible.

5. TRANSPORTATION:

Teams will be responsible for their own transportation to and from Deer Valley Resort, Park City Mountain Resort and the Salt Lake City International Airport. Park City Transportation is offering airport shuttles at a discounted rate of US \$64.00 per person/round trip for advanced bookings.
