

COVID-19 HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOL

for the participants

GENERAL PRINCIPLES

This protocol has been determined by current national regulations in France (Health Ministry, Sports Ministry, ARS, and CPAM). It takes into consideration recommendations made by the International Ski Federation (FIS).

Main principles:

- Sanitary groups to limit/avoid the interaction between people
- Strict protocols for the race bubble
- Limited access to areas (waiting area, start area, finish area)
- Strict respect of sanitary rules everywhere (masks, hand-washing, disinfection...)
- ❖ Obligation, for every member of the race bubble, to send prior to arrival by email to the organiser the contact form (annex n°1)



"RACE" BUBBLE TESTING PROTOCOL

Ski teams + Ski team staff + Club des sports + Course slippers + Patrollers + Ski instructors + Service providers + Volunteers + Medical team + Time team + Technical Delegates

To get accredited and every day, you need to:

- 1. Present:
- a complete vaccine certificate
- Or a negative nasal RT-PCR or antigenic test not older than 24 h
- Or a certificate of healing (a positiv test dated more than 11 days and less than 6 months)
- **→** Daily control
- 2. Fill out the Contact form (annex n°1)

On the arrival and during the event

In case of any doubts or symptoms: contact the Doctor designated by the organizers and make a test.

After the event

Contact the Doctor designated by the organizers for any typical symptom and any doubts, make a test and tell the organizers.



MASK POLICY

- ❖ Wearing a mask is **mandatory in all interior areas**
- ❖ Wearing a mask is mandatory in all gathering situations in exterior areas (waiting area, start area, finish area, ski lifts...)
- ❖ Wearing a mask is **never required during sports practice**

SANITARY PROTOCOLS

Objectives and basic principles

Preserve the health of the athletes and all those involved in the event as well as the continuity of the races.



PROTECTION

Mandatory mask wearing Regular use of hydroalcoholic gel



DISTANCING

Respect for social distancing



SCREENING

Subscribe to the Covid-19 testing policy presented above, and in conjunction with the Ministry of Health



CONFINEMENT

Stay withing one's sanitary bubble and avoid all unplanned or unsafe outside contact



SECURITY

No interaction with the public (autographs and selfies are strictly prohibited)



TRANSPARENCY

Alert the doctors and organizing committee of any symptoms Identify any contacts at risk
