Hygiene concept for the competitions “Snowboard Worldcup Berchtesgaden” on 2022, March 19th-20th

Basis: - Framework Hygiene Concept for sport of the Bavarian State Ministry, as of 2021, Dez. 3rd
- 15. Bavarian Infection Protection Measures Ordinance, as of 2022, March 7th
- FIS Covid-19 World Cup Risk Management and Testing Protocol, as of 2022, Jan. 20th

Location: **Bischofsweisen / Götschen**

Basics:

Participation in the competitions is only possible with a negative Covid 19 PCR test result, which must not be older than 48 hours at the time of accreditation. After accreditation, the regulations of the FIS Covid 19 World Cup Risk Management apply.

The negative Covid-19 PCR test results and the health questionnaires must be submitted to the organising team via the FIS Passport system before the accreditation is issued (beginning 2 p.m. on Thursday 2022, March 17th).

There are 6 accreditation groups:

red = race / blue = organisation / yellow = press / green = slope /
black (raceoffice) = coaches, FIS, timekeeping / violet = VIP-area

Before the competition, all coaches and officials are informed of the applicable hygiene regulations, both orally in the team leader meeting and in writing in the tender.

As the organizer, we are obliged to reduce the number of accredited persons based on the COVID-19 situation as far as possible. Therefore, only team officials receive access to areas relevant to team and sport according to the respective FIS quotas. Persons outside the applicable FIS quota are not permitted.

The following persons are not permitted to participate in the competitions:

- People with currently proven SARS-CoV-2 infection
- persons subject to quarantine
- people with symptoms of acute respiratory disease of any severity or fever.

Coaches are responsible for communicating these provisions to their assigned athletes and for ensuring their implementation.

For all persons who are not accredited through the FIS Passport System, the following rules apply:

Participation or employment is only possible under the following conditions:

All volunteers (e. g. slope) need a 2 G certificate (vaccinated or recovered).

Employees of the construction companies (television, triceps, etc.), press representatives and coaches who carry out their regular professional activities on site need a 3 G certificate (vaccinated, recovered or tested).

Only then can the accreditations be issued.

Team Captains Meeting:

The team captains meeting will be held online. The link is visible in the invitation to competition. The jury and the timekeeper centrally manage the team captains meeting. The contact details of the organising team are noted in the invitation to competition.

The race numbers are hung up on a beam in front of the function building. The race number is collected and returned by the athlete himself immediately before and after the race.

For each competition, either new or freshly disinfected start numbers are used.

Hygienic Measures:

During the entire competition, the minimum distance requirement of 1.5 m must be observed. If the minimum distance cannot be reliably maintained, masks are required.

Masks are compulsory in enclosed spaces.

The necessary hygiene measures must be observed in the toilets.

Communication:

Communication is carried out via messenger services (contact coach WC).

The start and result lists in paper form are printed only for the jury and the organising team.

No times are recorded on the timeline, no lists of results are displayed. The times are made available online and live via the FIS website. Program changes, start lists, intermediate stages, disqualifications and result lists are made available online.

Entry into the function building is only allowed for coaches (1 coach per nation), for the jury and the organising team.

Renngelände / Race area:

The race site is closed off in such a way that only authorised persons (VIPs) invited by the organizer can gain access. These persons are subject to the 2 G rule (vaccinated or recovered).

A large accumulation of people must be avoided. There may be calls for this via loudspeakers.

The use of the lifts is only possible on presentation of a 2 G certificate and with FFP 2 mask.

The start and finish area is closed off as wide as possible to ensure the necessary distance of the athletes and coaches.

The starter and the starter judge must wear a mouth-nose cover in the form of an FFP2 mask.

The competition shall be conducted swiftly in compliance with all necessary safety guidelines.

Award Ceremony:

The award ceremony will take place in the open terrain as soon as possible after the end of the race. A presentation of the prizes will not take place. Prizes are placed on a podium and picked up by the winners themselves.

The organizer reserves the right to make consistent use of its domestic rights vis-à-vis persons who do not comply with the regulations. Violation of the Covid 19 Protocol and the Disciplinary Protocol may lead directly to the withdrawal of accreditation.
