Additional Race Info:

Athletes receive individual transponders at the first bib pick-up. Transponders stay with the athlete and must be used in all races. According to ICR 343.5 Competitors must wear/use all the means of identification (bibs, leg bibs, transponders, GPS...) provided by the organizer.

Transponders must be returned to the Race Office after the finish of last race. In case of losing bib or transponder, the competitor must pay a fee to the OC (20€ for a bib, 70€ for a transponder).

ICR 396.2.6 Cross-Country ski poles must be used with Cross-Country skiing tips must be used. Alternatively poles tips must have safety rigid plastic protections with diameter ≥30 mm. These protections must be placed maximum 45 mm above the metallic tips.

RULES FOR THE FIS ROLLER SKI WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS (Regarding to Junior World Ski Championship):

- <u>3.2.1.</u> For Roller Ski World Championships the basic quota is 4 athletes per category per discipline per nation.
- <u>3.2.2.</u> The last ROL WSC winner athletes of the same competitions authorised to start additionally for that ROL WSC competition.








INTERVAL C RACE COURSE 2,5 KM



INTERVAL C VENUE PLAN











Course maps and data

SPRINT COURSE 200 m (IN THE CITY, 12 RAINA STREET)












MASS START COURSE HEIGHT PROFILE

- FIS Rollerski World Cup and World Championships Rules (vear. 2023)
- International Competition Rules (ICR) Cross Country
- Juniors must be 2004 2008 years of birth. Competitor must have reached his 16th birthday before the end of calendar year. Seniors are from year 2003 and older.
- Guidelines for Rollerski Equipment Specification and Control
- Sprint Finals will be organized starting with 1/4 finals with top 16 from qualification and with 4 athletes in a heat.

Rollerski equipment

 For Individual Interval C and Team Sprint C competition OC will provide classical rollerskis

Model: FF V Active Classic

Wheels – rubber, wheel speed 2

Frame – aluminium, length – 725mm wheelbase, weight – 2270g/pair)

For Distance Mass start competition OC will provide skating rollerskis.

Model: FF Active Skate

Wheels – rubber, wheel speed 2.

Frame – aluminium, length – 640mm wheelbase, weight – 1890g/pair.

- All rollerskis and wheels will be marked. Athlete or team are not allowed to make any
 adjustments of skis or wheels including lubrication. Rollerskis must be returned after the
 race.
- Technical sponsor: FF ROLLERSKIS AS (Norway).

FF Active Skate - 100€
