Visas

To check if your nation requires a visa for entry to the United States, please visit the Department of State website. Contact ordaevents@orda.org to request a visa letter from the Organizing Committee.

Be aware that to enter in the Unites States (also via Canada) have to follow the ESTA / ETA regulation. Start the process in due time. Please refer to the following websites https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov/.

Transportation

Transportation will be provided by the LOC from the airport to the lodging location. Shuttles from the lodging location to the competition venue will be provided throughout the teams stay.

Official airport of the events for LOC transfer: Albany (NY/USA) or Montreal (CAN)

Depending on flight arrival time for FIS Officials rental cars may be provided.

Travel reimbursement will be made in accordance with FIS policies. Reimbursement for flights will be made at the market value for Economy Class. Those choosing to fly at a higher ticket class will be responsible for the difference in price.

Lodging

Accommodations have been reserved for athletes, coaches, and team physio at the United States Olympic and Paralympic Training Center in Lake Placid. Space is limited at this location. Requests for accommodations outside of the team's quota will be taken on a first come first serve basis.

All athletes, coaches and physios staying or utilizing the Training Center facilities must pass a background check.

Please be aware there is a mandatory 15-minute SafeSport advisory video that all who are staying at the Training Center will have to watch upon arrival to the facility. This will be done in the Adirondack Room.

COVID-19 Prevention

Participants in the FIS World Cup competitions must adhere to the vaccination requirements for travel to the US. Requirements for vaccine status are listed here https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/travelers/noncitizens-US-air-travel.html

In addition, please be prepared to follow local COVID guidelines, subject to change. The latest guidelines are for Essex Country, NY found on the CDC website.

Wax Cabins and Trailers

The Olympic Jumping Complex will have changing cabins and separate waxing spaces for the Teams located in the Athlete Warm-up Area. Cabins will be available from Tuesday, February 7 to Sunday February 12 and will require a \$50 cash deposit. Failure to return keys will result in the LOC retaining the deposit.

Race Offices

There are three points of contact for the teams. The competition Race Office is located in the Staging Building adjacent to the team cabins at the base of the jumping towers. There will be an additional satellite Race Office next to the team cabins.

There will be a hospitality office/team information center located in the Adirondack Room at the United States Olympic and Paralympic Training Center in Lake Placid just off the main entrance lobby.

Accreditation will take place at the United States Olympic and Paralympic Training Center when teams arrive and in the area hotels when officials check-in. Additional credentials will be available upon request in the main Race Office.

Gym
