Nekoma Mountain Ski Resorts Global Park

Hoshino Resort Nekoma Mountain (former Aruz Bandai & Nekoma Ski Resort) is a big slope with 33 courses and 13 lifts. The slopes with different expressions are spread out in the north and south of Nekomagatake (Mt. Nekomagatake) in the 100-meter-high "Bandaisan" mountain range. With the connecting lifts connecting the north area (former Nekoma ski area) and the south area (former Aruz Bandai), visitors can now enjoy the vast slopes more freely.

Bandai is one of the most snow blessed areas in Japan. The northern area (former Nekoma Ski Area) is over 1,000 meters above sea level, and the amount of snow that falls there is not only abundant, but also light because of the north-facing slopes, so the accumulated snow does not melt easily.
